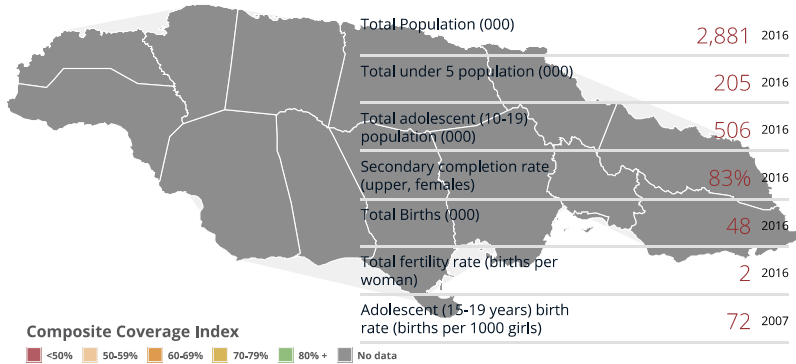

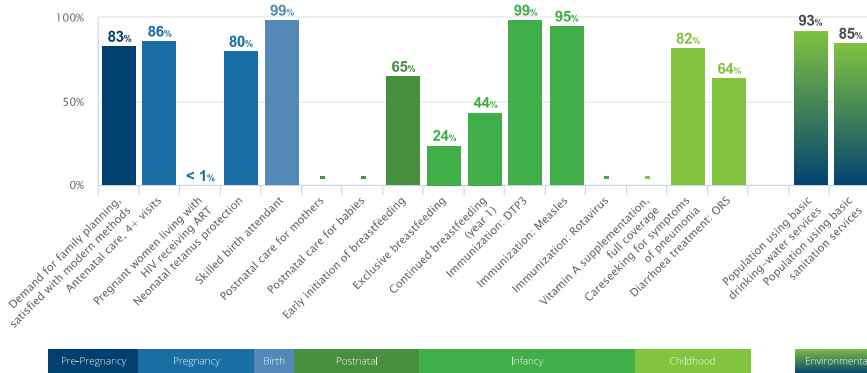

Composite Coverage Index

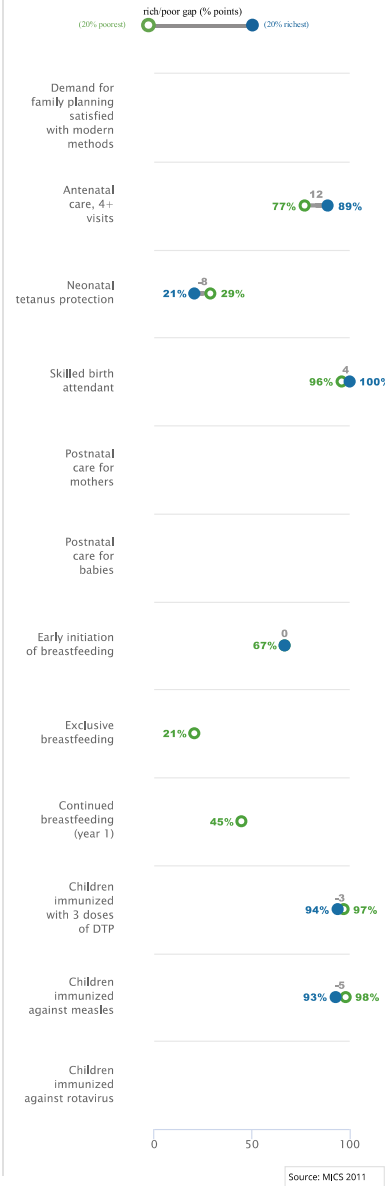


Continuum of Care Coverage

Percentage of those in need receiving coverage of key interventions across the continuum of care

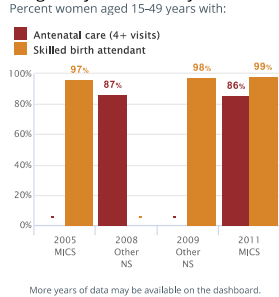

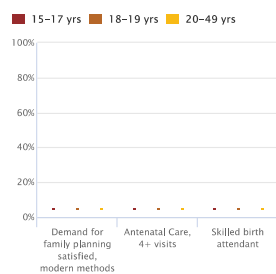

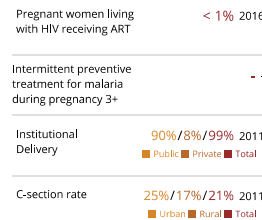

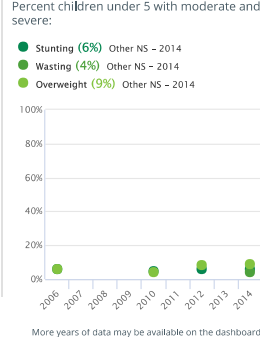

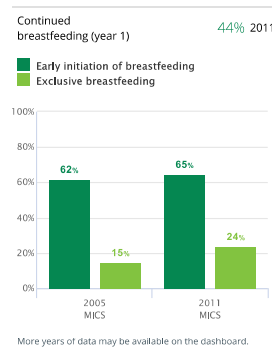

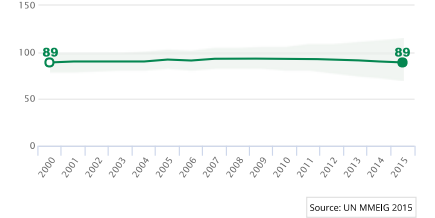

Maternal Mortality Ratio

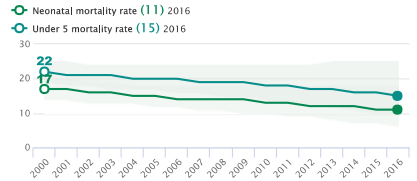
Deaths per 100,000 live births

Neonatal & Under-five Mortality Rate

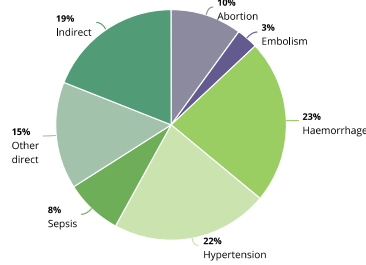

Causes of Maternal Death - 2014

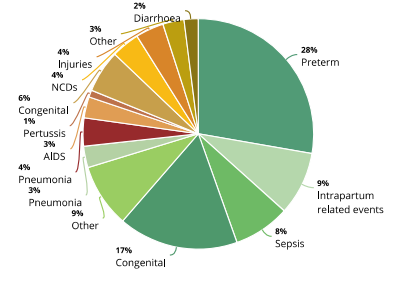
Regional estimates for Latin America & Caribbean

Children ages 1-59 months: 74% of deaths occur in the neonatal period

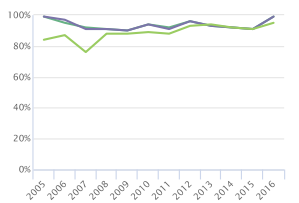

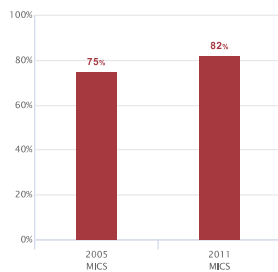

Pneumonia Treatment

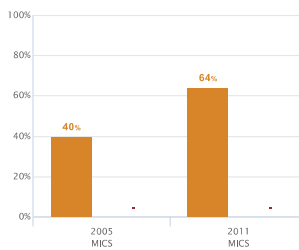
Percent of children under 5 years with symptoms of pneumonia taken to appropriate health provider



Diarrhoeal Disease Treatment

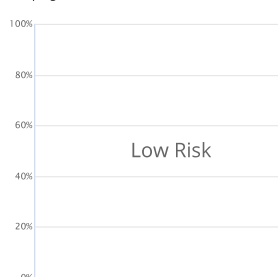
Percent of children under 5 years with diarrhoea:

Malaria prevention in children under-five - sleeping under ITNs

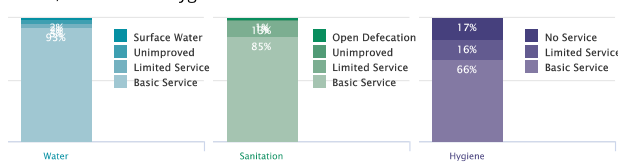


Malaria diagnostics in children under-five: Low Risk
